



Establish Learning Goals

- Learning Outcomes from Drake Curriculum

Identify measures and collect data

- Engage AOI faculty in designing assessment process (OIRA organizes meeting and provides guidance as needed)
- Samples of student work from AOI Courses
- Indirect Evidence – institutional surveys (NSSE, FLA-DSS longitudinal study, others)
- AOI faculty rating of student work (course embedded) with assessment survey completed by Faculty

Assess Student Learning

- AOI faculty review samples of student work
- OIRA summary of indirect evidence & AOI faculty rating
- AOI faculty & DCAC review results and formulates final recommendations

Use Results

- Results shared with AOI faculty in service of individual course revision (OIRA organizes meeting and provides guidance as needed)
- AOI faculty identify specific recommendations for implementation (University Curriculum Committee, Associate Provost of Curriculum and Instruction, AOI course development and revision)
- Faculty Senate and UCC provided summary of assessment process and use of results, and may be used to revise/establish learning goals
