5. FAR report
  - a. End of Year Survey-ask students about academic advising, wellness/welfare, resources, etc.
  - b. We can now track trends on this data
  - c. Seniors will meet with DeDe starting Monday, November 23<sup>rd</sup>
    - a. Based on sport experience, academic experience, and overall athletic experience
      - i. Spring 2015 - ~8% average likelihood to recommend Drake
      - ii. Fall 2014 - ~8% average (9.5% for academics)
    - b. Need to know how many seniors of each sport should be participating
  - d. 5<sup>th</sup> year seniors tend to have a more positive perspective on their experience
  - e. Question to add:
    - a. Did I play as much as I thought I should?
    - b. Did we deliver on our promise? – Use as introduction to survey
      - i. What were your expectations when you first came to Drake?
      - ii. How did we meet? How did we not meet?
  - f. NCAA discussing doing a student athlete survey to compare within leagues and conferences
    - a. 12 months out from utilizing this tool

- g. Face-to-face exercise allows them the opportunity to meet with someone outside of the department-demonstrating out care to get their issues addressed
- h. Research questions possibly don't add value
- i. Renae to send DeDe list of previous questions
