Proposed Statement

The principles of equal access and equal opportunity require that all interactions within the University be free from invidious discrimination.

Former approved Statement May 2004

The principles of equal access and equal opportunity require that all interactions within the University be free from invidious discrimination.

Drake University therefore prohibits ~~all forms of discrimination including discrimination~~ based upon race, color, national origin, ~~culture~~, creed, religion, age, ~~physical ability~~, sex, gender identity, sexual orientation or veteran status.
